

Adopt an Artifact

Help the Museum of the Albemarle protect our state treasures by adopting an artifact that requires conservation. Your tax-deductible donation in any amount will help support the museum's mission of preserving artifacts and other historical materials relating to the history and heritage of northeastern North Carolina.

Museum of the Albemarle staff will locate a conservator with specific expertise in the type of material needing care. That person will do a conservation assessment of the work needed to conserve the object plus the cost of materials, their time, and travel. At that point, a contract will be written identifying the duration of the project and the monetary requirements. Sometimes these amounts will need to be amended due to further needs uncovered during the conservation process.

There will be follow-up articles published in "The Gateway," the quarterly newsletter for the Museum of the Albemarle, tracking the progress of each conservation project. Individuals or groups may elect to adopt an artifact, and any amount will be accepted gratefully. To recognize contributors to Adopt an Artifact, each donor will be listed alphabetically in "The Gateway" without dollar amount. Should a donor prefer not to be recognized in such manner, check the *No* blank in the form below.
